The start of our new fiscal year has brought about some important changes in the pantry. First and foremost, we are now up and running with our new computer database, Link2Feed. This software program links together our pantry with the Oregon Food Bank, and other pantries in Oregon who chose to use this system. By doing so, it allows the Oregon Food Bank to get a more accurate picture of hunger in Oregon, which in turn will allow us to provide more services in the future. We are very excited about the implementation of this program, which wouldn't have been possible without the many, amazing volunteers who have put in countless hours of their time. I am confident that the FISH Pantry has the best volunteers in all of Douglas County! They truly are the reason this program has had such a successful start.

Second, The FISH Pantry no longer has a children's prescription medication assistance program. Effective July 1st, 2019, we ceased providing up to \$75.00 for children's medication assistance.
