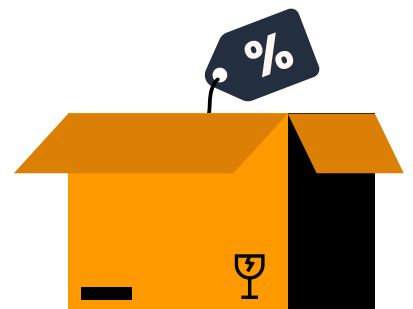
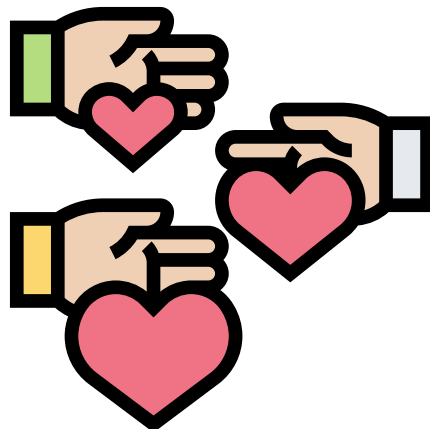
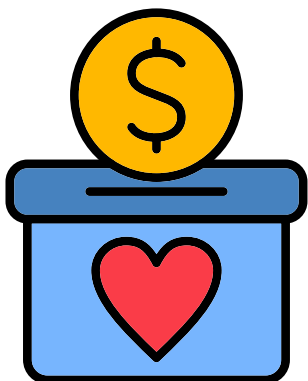


Join Our Development Team + Wishlist Champion Wanted!

A HUGE Thank you to our First Responder team at AVIVA health. We are so grateful for all that you do for our community. They brought over so many nuts when we were running low.

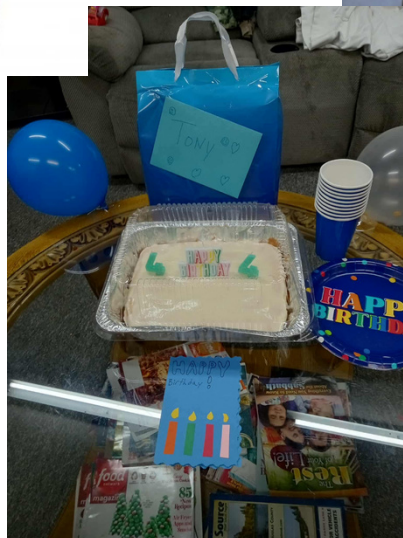

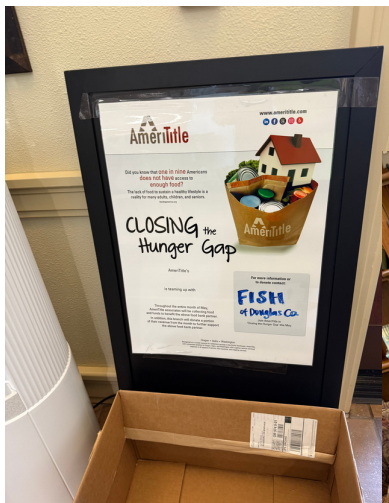
Thank you Douglas County Master Gardeners, what an amazing donation. I wish that you could see the excitement that happened as clients got to pick their own plants.
